



**AGREEMENT OF SCHOLARLY EXCHANGES BETWEEN  
THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF PHARMACY  
AND CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF PHARMACY**

The goal of the cooperating institutions is to foster advancement of pharmacy education, promote scientific research, and enhance understanding and collaboration between the faculties and students of China Medical University College of Pharmacy (CMU-COP) and The Ohio State University College of Pharmacy (OSU-COP)

Specifically, the institutions resolve to accomplish the following on a reciprocal basis

- Admit selected predoctoral students and fellows nominated by either institution into the graduate education program of the other for course offerings and for education, training and collaboration in research;
- Place selected postdoctoral research fellows in the pharmaceutical sciences in laboratories within CMU-COP and OSU-COP and their affiliated institutions;
- Offer exchange clerkships for academic credit to senior pharmacy students;
- Promote faculty exchanges, including opportunities for scholars and clinical specialists to undertake short-term visits for lectures, consultations, and to participate in colloquia and seminars;
- Explore the feasibility of exchanging senior pharmacists and postdoctoral clinical fellows within graduate pharmacy education programs of The Ohio State University affiliated teaching hospitals and China Medical University Hospital;
- Exchange information and plans for curriculum design and development with the objective of replicating models of pharmacy education that are transferable; and
- Develop additional collaborative programs in the future.




The structure for administering the exchange programs, procedures for admission, annual number and qualification of students and faculty, placement of predoctoral and postdoctoral fellows in specific departmental education programs, visas, housing, tuition, health insurance and receipt of academic credit will be addressed separately as appendices to the agreement, or developed as needed on a case-by-case basis.


This agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years following ratification by The Ohio State University College of Pharmacy and the Administrative Council of China Medical University University. It may be renewed if both institutions so desire after the expiration of five years. Either party may terminate this agreement without cause after 90 days notice.
