



Agreement for Academic Exchange and Collaboration  
Between  
Tulane University  
and  
China Medical University

1. Tulane University and China Medical University, desire to promote cooperation in education and academic research, agree to the following:
  - 1.1 to encourage exchange and visits in the following categories: graduate students, non-teaching and post-graduate fellows, and junior and senior faculty members.
  - 1.2 to exchange information and materials in the area of interest to both universities.
  - 1.3 to organize joint conferences and academic programs.
  - 1.4 to arrange joint research activities and publications.
2. Specific details for the implementation of any of the above listed activities will be negotiated and developed as the needs arise.
3. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of three years. It shall be extended automatically for an additional period of three years at each expiration date unless either party gives six months' advance notice in writing to terminate the Agreement.
