CLINICAL TRAINING COOPERATION AGREEMENT

This Agreement, dated November 3th, 2009, is between:

- 1. College of Chinese Medicine, China Medical University, Taiwan, [No.91 Hsueh-Shih Road, Taichung, Taiwan] (CCM-CMU); and
- 2. Five Branches University, [200 7th Avenue, Santa Cruz, CA 95062, USA (FBU)

(each a "PARTY" and collectively, the "PARTIES").

WHEREAS the parties mutually agree through amicable negotiation that cooperation on clinical training can enhance clinical skills of the students,

NOW, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1:FBU may send students for internship at CCM-CMU and delegate short-term teaching and clinical training to the latter.
- 2. Number and Requirement of Students: FBU will assign students with required education background in Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine for internship at CCM-CMU in ONE batch every year and up to TWENTY students per batch.
- 3. Course Arrangement Course provided for FBU interns at CCM-CMU for the year 2009 is as follows:

4. Tuition and Fees

- 4.1 Tuition and fees charged by CCM-CMU, including course material and honorary for lecturers, for the year 2009 is set at NT\$ 2,000 per day for a duration of 12 days and total NT\$ 24,000 for each student.
- 4.2 Transportation, room and board, and other expenses will be provided by FBU.
- 5. Credential

Students who have fulfilled the course requirement will be issued a certificate in the form as Attachment 1.

6. Other matters pertaining to the Clinical Training Cooperation that are not covered in this agreement will be decided through additional negotiations between the Parties.
