PHYSICAL THERAPY STUDENT PLACEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN

KANSAI ELECTRIC POWER HOSPITAL

AND

CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY

1. COMMITMENT

1.1 The two institutions share a commitment to deepening the international dimension of their activities and recognize the value of providing students with opportunities for undertaking aspects of their academic studies overseas and of welcoming international students onto their programmes of study.

2. SCOPE

- 2.1 Both institutions agree to:
 - 2.1.1 Encourage co-operation between their respective departments.
 - 2.1.2 Encourage the exchange of academic and clinical staff.
 - 2.1.3 Facilitate undergraduate student exchange across subject areas within their respective regulatory frameworks.
- 2.2 Study abroad students:
 - 2.2.1 Study abroad students will be responsible for their own travel, accommodation, cost of living and insurance costs and will pay the agreed study abroad fee to their host institution.
- 2.3 Admission and credit transfer
 - 2.3.1 Each institution will retain the right to accept or reject application for exchange or study abroad according to its own admissions requirements and regulations.

3. DURATION AND ANDMINISTRATION

3.1 This agreement covers an initial period of five years and may be terminated by either party with written notice of one semester.

3.2 The agreement will be administered by Kansai Electric Power Hospital and by the department of Physical Therapy at China Medical University
