



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### BETWEEN

## DUY TAN UNIVERSITY DANANG, VIETNAM

#### AND

# CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY TAICHUNG, TAIWAN

In order to promote cooperation and the advancement of academic and educational exchanges between Duy Tan University (DTU) and China Medical University (CMU), the two institutions agree as follows:

- 1. DTU and CMU agree to develop the following activities in academic areas of mutual interest:
  - a. Academic visits:
  - b. Exchange of faculty, researchers and other research and administrative staff;
  - c. Exchange of students;
  - d. Collaborative research projects;
  - e. Lectures and symposia;
  - f. Exchange of academic information and materials;
  - g. Other forms of academic cooperation
- 2. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is only to express the intentions of the Parties. The term of cooperation for each specific activity contemplated under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing

by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such activities agreed upon will be recorded and governed by a separate document executed by both parties. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon. This Memorandum of Understanding imposes no financial obligations on either party. Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

- 3. This Memorandum of Understanding will remain current for five years with the understanding that either party may terminate it by giving the other party a written notice twelve months in advance, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon.
- 4. Each party shall not make any public announcement or statement or publish or release any information in relation to any proposed activity or proposed collaboration without the prior written approval of both parties. Each party shall keep confidential any information that it receives from the other party which is marked confidential or which a party notifies the other party is confidential.
