RESEARCH CENTER FOR HEALTHY AGING
AT CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, TAICHUNG, TAIWAN



For the purpose of international cooperation in both education and academic research, the above two parties hereby affirm their intent to promote such academic cooperation and program exchanges as will be of mutual benefit to their respective school. Academic cooperation and program exchange include but are not limited to:

1. Exchange of graduate students, faculty members, academic staffs, and researchers
2. Coordination of international joint research
3. Co-organization of invited talks, seminar lectures, and international symposia
4. Exchange of research materials, publications, and scientific information in the fields of mutual interest
5. Mutual implementation of innovative ideas

Details of the implementation of any particular initiative resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated between the two school units as each specific case may arise. Both parties understand that financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of educational and research funds.

This Memorandum of Understanding becomes effective upon completion of the signatures.
