



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITAS AIRLANGGA, INDONESIA
AND
CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “MOU”) is made and entered into on Nov 1, 2023 between:

UNIVERSITAS AIRLANGGA, INDONESIA, a public institution of higher education under Statute of Universitas Airlangga, represented by Prof. Dr. Mohammad Nasih, as Rector, appointed under Decree of the Board of Trustees of Universitas Airlangga No.3/UN3.MWA/K/2020 dated 16 July 2020, for and on behalf of Universitas Airlangga, of which the address is Campus C Mulyorejo, Surabaya, Jawa Timur, Indonesia 60115 (hereinafter referred to as “UNAIR”), and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns,

and

CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN, a private institution of higher education under Statute of China Medical University, represented by Prof. Mien-Chie Hung, Ph.D., as President, appointed under Decree of the Board of Trustees of China Medical University, for and on behalf of China Medical University, of which the address is No. 100, Sec. 1, Jingmao Rd., Beitun Dist., Taichung City 406040, Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as “CMU”), and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns.

The purpose of this MOU is to express the Parties’ intention for mutual cooperation and does not constitute nor create, and will not give rise to any legally binding or enforceable obligations, either expressed or implied, under both domestic and international law. The Parties may enter into separate formal, legally binding agreements in writing pertaining to their various joint activities, which will fully document the rights and obligations of each Party. The Parties hereby confirm their mutual understanding as follows:

ARTICLE 1 AREAS OF COLLABORATION AND COOPERATION

- (1) Within the context of their respective mandates, objectives and procedures, the collaboration between Parties will focus on the following areas:
 - a) academic cooperation,
 - b) research collaboration,
 - c) community services.
- (2) Any future cooperation will be considered, on a case-by-case basis, upon the merit of each case and within the limitations of the mandate and resources of each Party.

ARTICLE 2 CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties shall be held accountable for the confidentiality of any information and/or data which are exchanged, acquired and shared amongst the parties throughout the course of activities and/or any other projects conducted in accordance with this MOU, unless said data and/or information has already been registered in public domain prior to this MOU.

ARTICLE 3 NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organisation of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

ARTICLE 4 NOTICES

Any communication under this MOU will be written in English and delivered via addresses that the Parties have provided below, as well as to other addresses that either Party notify to the sender beforehand during the course of the effective years of this MOU, and shall be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the addresses provided in this document and/or any other contact information that the Parties have mutually agreed to in advance.

ARTICLE 5 ENTRY INTO EFFECT, DURATION AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall enter into force for 5 (five) years from the date of its signing and may be amended and/or terminated by mutual consent, subject to at least 6 (six) month prior written notice of such amendment/termination to the other Party from the proposed date of amendment/termination. Any ongoing activities under this MOU will not be affected by such amendment/termination and will continue to apply until their completion.

Signed in duplicates, each in English and Bahasa Indonesia, as well as any other languages mutually agreed upon by the Parties, all texts being equally authentic. In the event of any divergence of interpretation between any of the texts, the English text shall prevail.
