



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
*Between*  
UNIVERSITAS MUHAMMADIYAH YOGYAKARTA  
*And*  
CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY  
TAIWAN



**1. Preamble**

In accordance with the mutual desire to foster cooperation between China Medical University and Universitas Muhammadiyah Yogyakarta, and to explore the potential for collaboration in the areas set out below, the two institutions have signed the following Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

**2. Areas for potential collaboration**

Based on the principles of mutual benefit, both institutions intend to explore opportunities for:

- (a) Movement of students between two institutions;
- (b) Movement of faculty, scholars and staff between two institutions;
- (c) Development of joint curriculum, including dual degree programs;
- (d) Research collaboration in the fields with mutual interest between research staff, departments, and schools of both institutions;
- (e) Exchange and sharing of teaching and academic materials, publications, reference, and other pertinent information;
- (f) All of the above with special reference to the cultural, economic, ethical, political, and social implications of contemporary technology in the global context.

**3. Implementation of Memorandum**

Both institutions agree that specific projects and activities shall be developed for implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding based on discussions and negotiations between the two institutions. Agreements or contracts shall be signed separately to carry out these projects and activities.

Both institutions agree that all financial arrangements shall be determined on the basis of specific projects and activities, and will depend on the availability of funding.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of the two institutions and shall remain valid for a period of five years. This MoU shall be renewed by mutual consent.
