



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY  
COLLEGE OF HEALTH CARE

AND

JUNTENDO UNIVERSITY  
FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCE



China Medical University College of Health Care (No.91, Hsueh-Shih Road, Taichung 40402, Taiwan) and Juntendo University Faculty of Health Science (2-1-1 Hongo, Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo 113-8421, JAPAN) have mutually agreed upon this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to strengthen their collaborative and exchange relations.

### 1. Purposes

This MOU is the foundation for the promotion of the following future forms of collaboration:

- Collaborative academic programs and research initiatives;
- Exchange of students, faculty, and staff;
- Exchange of academic materials;
- Exchange of information regarding conferences, symposiums, and seminars;
- Other activities mutually agreed upon by both parties that will strengthen the partnership between both universities.

### 2. Functions

#### 2.1 Administrative Guidelines

Each party acknowledges that any form of collaboration derived from the purposes of this MOU must be approved by the appropriate authorities and must meet the administrative guidelines of both parties. Programs or activities that do not meet the administrative guidelines already in place at the host institution will require a separate mutually agreed upon written contract.

#### 2.2 Conduct

Each party acknowledges that in the case students, faculty, or staff visit the other party or participate in exchange programs they must obey the laws of the host country and the regulations of the host party.

### 2.3 Financial Expenses

Each party acknowledges that neither party will have any financial obligations to the other party, unless stated in a separate mutually agreed upon written agreement.

### 2.4 Equal Opportunity

Each party agrees not to discriminate against any person based on age, sex, gender, sexual orientation, race, social class, ethnicity, nationality, or religion.

## 3. Terms and Conditions

### 3.1 Representatives

China Medical University is represented by Dean Cheng-Chun Lee and Juntendo University is represented by Faculty of Health Science Dean Hiroyuki DAIDA.

### 3.2 Duration

This MOU becomes effective after the representatives of both parties sign the MOU and will continue to be effective until both parties mutually agree to terminate the MOU in a separate written contract. Termination of the MOU will not influence any ongoing programs or activities, unless mutually agreed upon in a separate written contract.

### 3.3 Modification

Each party may propose a modification to the MOU at any time. Each party must mutually agree to the modification for the change to become effective.

### 3.4 Communication

Each party will have an administrative office responsible for communications with the other party. 3.5 Legality

Each party acknowledges that the MOU states mutually agreed upon purposes and understandings. This MOU is not legally binding. Each party may propose a legally binding contract derived from the purposes of the MOU at any time.


3.6 Third Party


