



AGREEMENT BETWEEN CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY AND FUJITA HEALTH UNIVERSITY

CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (official address: No. 100, Section 1, Jingmao Road, Beitun District, Taichung City, 406040, Taiwan) legally represented by the President, Professor Mien-Chie Hung

AND

FUJITA HEALTH UNIVERSITY (official address: 1-98 Dengakugakubo, Kutsukake-cho, Toyoake, Aichi 470-1192, Japan) legally represented by the President, Professor Yukio Yuzawa.

WHEREAS

The above-mentioned institutions agree to implement a scientific and academic cooperation programme between the two Universities.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1 – China Medical University and Fujita Health University intend to promote and strengthen scientific and academic cooperation by means of exchanging professors, researchers, as well as students and other staff.

Article 2 - In the frame of the present Agreement, each Party will designate their own representative who will arrange a yearly joint programme of work and the necessary funding scheme, according to Articles 1, and who will verify the fulfilment of the expected aims.

Article 3 - The scientific and academic cooperation will be implemented through further written Agreements, subject to the approval of both the academic board of Fujita Health University and the academic committee of China Medical University. The Parties will jointly or individually seek funding from national or international bodies and organizations to finance the scheduled activities. No activity shall be accomplished without the necessary financial support.

Article 4 - Both parties agree to set up a Credit Transfer System for qualifying Students who intend to transfer acquired credits.

Article 5 - Each Party will pay travel and subsistence costs of its own staff participating in the exchange programme according to its own financial resources. Details of the cost agreement would be written in the appendix created by each school and college.

Article 6 - The students from both Parties participating in the exchange programme are exempt from paying enrolment and other taxes at the host university. The students meet all administrative duties appertaining to their own University.

Article 7 - Anything regarding intellectual and industrial property, as well as patents and inventions that may result from common research activities, will be regulated by specific written Agreements.

Article 8 - The partner Universities shall make every effort to reach an out-of-court settlement for any disputes that arise on signing or performing this Agreement.


Article 9 - This Agreement shall enter into force following its signature by all the contracting Parties. It shall be binding upon the Parties hereto for a period of five (5) years. The Agreement may be renewed or modified by means of a written notice approved by both the academic board of Fujita Health University and the academic committee of China Medical University. The Parties may withdraw from the present Agreement by giving six month's written notice prior to its expiration. This agreement is effective when the representatives of both institutions have signed and dated the document.

Article 10 - The present Agreement will be signed in two originals in English.


