



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)



between

HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY
and
CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY
on

Academic and Research Collaboration

Hasanuddin University and China Medical University acknowledge and wish to conduct the mutually beneficial collaboration and set out the following protocols to govern their collaboration on academic and research-related activities.

Scope

The scope of collaboration on academic and research activities included in this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) may include the following categories:

- Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest;
- Exchange of academic materials which are made available by both parties;
- Exchange of scholars;
- Student mobility;
- Cooperative seminars, workshops, and other academic activities.

Implementation

To implement this MOU, the following is mutually understood:

- Proposals for collaborative work under this MOU will be submitted through the normal procedures of each party.
- This MOU allows for the development of separate faculty-to-faculty written agreements wherein cooperative arrangements limited to those faculties are specified.
- Each party will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of any cooperative program. Individual programs of work developed under this MOU will be subject to individual agreements in writing and where appropriate will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
- Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by designated project officers of both parties, in accordance with its individual written agreement.
- The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of the guaranteed support funds.
- Neither Hasanuddin University nor China Medical University will be held responsible for any liability, and neither party shall be required to purchase any insurance against any loss or damage to any personal property to which this MOU relates.
- Neither party will be legally bound in any way whatsoever by entering into this MOU and nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal or financial relationship between the parties. Only the individual written agreements, if any, will create legally binding obligations between the parties.

Commencement, renewal, termination, and amendment

This MOU is effective as of 01/11/2023

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of 5 (five) years from the above-mentioned date, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving at least 6 (six) months' notice to the other party in writing.

This MOU may be amended or extended by mutual consent in writing of the two parties.



