



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

FACULTY OF PHARMACY UNIVERSITAS GADJAH MADA (UGM) AND COLLEGE OF PHARMACY CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (CMU) ON ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH COLLABORATION

On this day (October 25, 2023) at (China Medical University), the undersigned:

- I. Prof. Dr. Satibi, M.Si. Apt. Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM), acting on behalf of Faculty of Pharmacy UGM, having its principal office in Sekip Utara, Yogyakarta 55281, hereafter referred to as Faculty of Pharmacy UGM/First Party.
- II. Prof. Shin-Hun Juang, Dean of College of Pharmacy China Medical University (CMU), acting on behalf of College of Pharmacy CMU, having its principal office in No. 100, Section 1, Jingmao Road, Beitun District, Taichung City 406040, Taiwan, hereafter referred as College of Pharmacy CMU/Second Party.

Faculty of Pharmacy UGM and College of Pharmacy CMU altogether are Parties and each is Party.

The Parties are desirous of entering into this MoA to establish a basis of cooperation and collaboration upon the terms as contained herein.

Hereby both Parties agree as follows:

Article 1

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to promote international understanding, scholarly collaboration, cultural interaction and friendship by supporting educational, professional, and cultural activities among faculty and students of the two institutions. Accordingly, the areas of cooperation will include, subject to mutual consent, any program offered at either university as felt desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides feel contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

Article 2

Area of Cooperation

Specific areas of cooperation between the two institutions, subject to the availability of funds and the approval of both Parties, include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1. Exchange of faculty members;
- 2. Exchange of students;
- 3. Joint research activities;
- 4. Joint degree program in the field of Pharmacy
- 5. Participate in seminars and academic meetings;
- 6. Exchange of academic materials and other information;
- 7. Short-term academic programs.

To implement the activities mentioned above, the following steps will be described in detail in separate addendums.

Article 3

Financial Arrangement

Both Parties agree to discuss and further negotiate the specific budget details in separate proposal(s) before the implementation of any such joint program(s) or joint research project(s). This MoA shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.

Article 4

Validity and Termination

This MoA is valid from the date of last signature by person authorized and shall remain in effect for the period of 5 (five) years. This MoA is subject to an extension with prior consent of both Parties. Either Party may terminate this MoA by notifying the other Party about its intention to terminate this MoA by a written notice, at least 3 (three) months prior to its termination date. Termination shall be without penalty.
