



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

HANYANG UNIVERSITY

And

CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY

No. 100, Sec. 1, Jingmao Rd., Beitun Dist., Taichung City 406040, Taiwan R.O.C.

Represented by President Mien-Chie Hung

HANYANG UNIVERSITY and CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (hereafter collectively referred to as "the parties") agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for academic cooperation and to promote the advancement of learning through exchanges and collaboration in teaching and research.

ARTICLE I AREAS OF COOPERATION

- 1.1 Within the fields of study to be mutually designated, the parties agree to the following general areas of cooperation:
 - Joint research in the fields of mutual interest to the parties
 - Exchanges of faculty, research personnel, and students between the parties for research and study
 - Exchanges of faculty and staff members for participation in conferences, seminars, and workshops
 - Exchanges of materials in education, research, publications, and academic information

ARTICLE II

ARRANGEMENT AND FUNDING

2.1 The implementation of any and all exchanges or study abroad programs will be discussed separately and determined by the parties by way of separate agreements. Specific initiatives may be considered and agreed upon, on a case by case basis, with consideration to the contributions and obligations of each member of the parties.

- 2.2 Each initiative shall be discussed to reach mutual agreement of the parties and shall be formalized by a signed addendum to this MOU.
- 2.3 The parties acknowledge that unless otherwise agreed upon, all expenses concerning salaries, traveling, living and associated costs will be determined at the discretion and responsibility of the participant's home institution or by the participant.

ARTICLE III

EFFECT OF AGREEMENT

- 3.1 This MOU will be valid for a period of five (5) years, and will automatically be renewed for additional 5-year periods, unless one of the contracting parties notifies the other in writing its intent to terminate at least three (3) months in advance of termination date
- 3.2 The renewal or cessation of the MOU shall be discussed by the parties at least six (6) months prior to the end of the period of validity.
- 3.3 Should either of the party members wish to withdraw from the MOU prior to the end of the period of validity, they may do so by providing six (6) months prior written notice.
- 3.4 The parties agree to review this agreement every five (5) years in order to evaluate the progress and improve the quality of the exchanges.
- 3.5 This MOU shall be drawn up in two (2) copies in English. One (1) copy of this agreement will be retained at each member of the parties.
