



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, COLLEGE OF CHINESE MEDICINE
TAICHUNG, TAIWAN
&
JASEUNG HOSPITAL OF KOREAN MEDICINE,
REPUBLIC OF SOUTH KOREA**

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into on June 23, 2025, by and between:

1. **China Medical University, College of Chinese Medicine**, an academic institution located in Taichung, Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as "CMUCCM"); and
2. **Jaseung Hospital of Korean Medicine**, an institution registered and operating in the Republic of South Korea (hereinafter referred to as "JASENG").

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for academic exchange and ongoing collaboration between CMUCCM and JASENG to provide clinical and academic training and educational opportunities for CMUCCM faculty and students.

2. Scope of Collaboration

The Parties agree to cooperate in the following areas:

1. Facilitating CMUCCM faculty and student exchanges for clinical training, educational activities, and other various academic activities.
2. Developing joint academic programs, seminars, workshops and research.
3. Sharing educational expertise and best practices in integrative medicine.
4. Promoting cross-institutional engagement through various activities.
5. Exploring opportunities for clinical observation at CMU Hospital as well as internships and practical training at JASENG.

3. Nature of the Agreement

This MoU is not legally binding and serves only as a statement of intent for cooperation. Any binding agreements or commitments shall be established through subsequent detailed agreements.

4. Duration, Termination and Modification of Agreement

This MOU shall take effect when signed by the official representatives of the institutions involved and will remain in effect for an initial period of *five (5)* years and may be extended by mutual agreement in writing for additional *five (5)* year periods. Either Party may terminate this MOU with six (6) months written notice of intent to terminate. Any modification shall require the prior written approval of CMUCCM and JASENG or their designees.

5. Cooperation with Third Parties

CMUCCM and JASENG may identify other agencies or institutions for joint participation in mutually agreed upon projects and activities and will be defined in writing for mutual agreement. CMUCCM or JASENG may individually execute cooperative and collaborative research, education and training, economic development and other activities with other



organizations independent of this MOU and of each other.

6. Support and Resources

This MOU does not obligate either CMUCCM or JASENG to provide funds and/or other resources from its own or other sources unless agreed to in writing. CMUCCM and JASENG may jointly or individually seek funding and other support from third parties for the conduct of collaborative projects, programs and/or activities. Neither institution (CMUCCM or JASENG) accepts any liability for accidents, injury or death occurring to student or faculty participants during the term of this agreement, nor any liability for debts or damages, including against loss or damage to any personal property, incurred by participants during the period of the agreement.

7. General Understanding

This MoU is a mutual expression of goodwill and intent to collaborate in advancing integrative medicine education. It does not impose any legal obligations on either Party.

8. Signatures

Only signatories listed below or their appointed representatives may make changes to this MOU and addenda provided that both parties mutually agree upon such changes in writing.
