**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH, CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN
AND
SCHOOL OF HEALTH INNOVATION, KANAGAWA UNIVERSITY OF
HUMAN SERVICES**

This Agreement is entered into between the College of Public Health, China Medical University, Taiwan, and School of Health Innovation, Kanagawa University of Human Services, Japan (hereinafter referred to as “parties”).

The parties hereto agree as follows:

Article 1.

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the parties here agree that the following academic cooperation may be pursued:

- a) Participation in symposia and conferences on public health and related topics;
- b) Exchange of researchers and postgraduate students between the two parties;
- c) Collaborative cross-national research on public health and related topics.

Article 2.

This Agreement expresses the intentions of the parties to facilitate academic cooperation and places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either of the parties. The terms for a specific activity under this Agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon by both of the parties prior to the initiation of the activity. Each of the parties shall designate an institutional contact person to facilitate a specific activity.

Article 3.

This Agreement remains effective for a period of five years from the latter date of the signing indicated below. Its period of validity may be extended by the mutual agreement between the parties. Either party may, by giving six months written notice to the other party, terminate this Agreement during its period of validity.

Article 4.

This Agreement is created in duplicate in English, each of which shall be deemed originals.

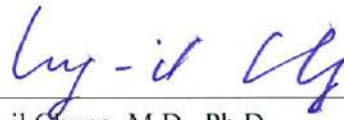

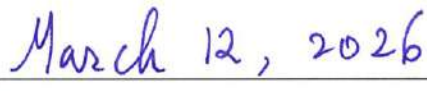
