



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY
AND
PATHUMTHANI UNIVERSITY
FOR MUTUAL ACADEMIC COOPERATION**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made this day of 28 November 2025 (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") between CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as "CMU"), located at No.100, Section 1, Jingmao Road, Beitun District, Taichung City 406040, Taiwan and PATHUMTHANI UNIVERSITY (hereinafter referred to as "PTU"), located at 140 Moo 4 Tiwanon Road, Ban Klang, Mueang, Pathum Thani District, Pathum Thani, Thailand 12000, for the purpose of fostering mutual understanding and academic collaboration. This MOU reflects the shared intent of both institutions to promote academic exchange, build meaningful partnerships, and develop future joint activities based on mutual interest, respect, and goodwill.

1. PURPOSE

"PTU" and "CMU" express a shared commitment to strengthening international collaboration in higher education. This MOU aims to build a foundation for future cooperation through academic exchanges, joint activities, and mutual learning, in the spirit of friendship, reciprocity, and mutual benefit.

2. AREAS OF COOPERATION

Both institutions agree to explore and develop the following areas of collaboration, subject to further agreement:

- 2.1 Exchange of faculty, staff, and students
- 2.2 Joint research, publications, and academic projects
- 2.3 Co-hosting of lectures, workshops, conferences, or seminars
- 2.4 Exchange of academic resources and materials
- 2.5 Other mutually agreed academic activities

3. IMPLEMENTATION

3.1 Activities under this Memorandum shall be discussed and agreed upon separately in writing through specific Memoranda of Agreement (MOA), as needed.

3.2 Each institution shall be responsible for its own expenses unless otherwise agreed.

3.3 Both parties shall assign coordinators to facilitate communication and cooperation.

3.4 All activities and collaborations under this MOU shall be conducted in accordance with applicable laws, international regulations, and universally accepted standards of ethics and morality.

4. TERM AND RENEWAL

This MOU shall be effective for five (5) years from the date of signing and may be extended by mutual written agreement prior to its expiration.

5. AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION

5.1 Any amendment to this MOU shall be made in writing with the consent of both parties.

5.2 Either party may terminate this MOU by giving thirty (30) days' written notice in the case of serious breach or inability to cooperate.

5.3 Termination shall not affect any ongoing or completed activity that has been conducted properly in accordance with this MOU. However, any activity found to be in violation of the agreed terms, laws, or ethical standards may be suspended or terminated immediately by either party.

5.4 Both parties agree that all discussions and modifications shall be conducted amicably and in good faith. This MOU is intended for academic cooperation and is not legally binding; however, both parties are expected to honor the spirit and intent of this agreement with integrity and responsibility.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

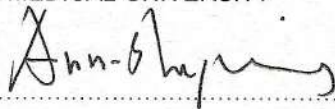
