

AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, THE UNIVERSITY OF TOKYO, JAPAN
AND
COLLEGE OF MEDICINE, CHINA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, TAIWAN

This Agreement is entered into between the Graduate School of Medicine, the University of Tokyo, Japan, and the College of Medicine, China Medical University, Taiwan (hereinafter referred to as “parties”).

The parties hereto agree as follows:

Article 1.

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the parties here agree that the following academic cooperation may be pursued:

- a) Participation in symposia and conferences on medical sciences and related topics;
- b) Exchange of researchers and postgraduate students between the parties;
- c) Collaborative cross-national research on medical sciences and related topics;
- d) Exchange of academic information and materials.

Article 2.

This Agreement expresses the intentions of the parties to facilitate academic cooperation and places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either of the parties. The terms for a specific activity under this Agreement shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon by both of the parties prior to the initiation of the activity. Each of the parties shall designate an institutional contact person to facilitate a specific activity.

The activity shall be carried out in compliance with laws and regulations to be followed by the parties concerned.

Article 3.

In the case that research results impacting upon matters of intellectual property rights are expected to arise in the course of collaborative projects carried out under the terms of Article 1 above, the parties shall discuss in good faith and agree in a separate document the conditions regarding the treatment of intellectual property rights so arising, prior to the start of the collaborative project in question and in accordance with the policies of each party.

Article 4.

This Agreement remains effective for a period of five years from the latter date of the signing indicated below. Its period of validity may be extended by the mutual agreement between the parties. Either party may, by giving six months advance written notice to the other party, terminate this Agreement during its period of validity. In the event of expiration or termination of this Agreement, the terms of this Agreement shall remain effective for all projects and activities which have already launched under separate agreements.

Article 5.

This Agreement is created in duplicate in English, each of which shall be deemed originals.

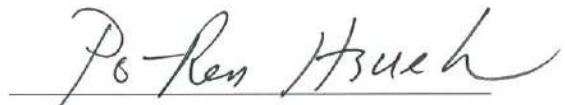
