

Hardships for Students to Study Abroad

Introduction

The hardships for students who need extra help to meet their living or course costs to study abroad, sponsored by the Ministry of Education Taiwan, is intended to subsidize those students to attend either exchange or joint degree program in outstanding overseas universities. Those students are selected by their university. The goal of the program is to give recipients opportunities to get involved in an overseas institute and extend their vision.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a citizen of the Republic of China (Taiwan).
- The applicant must hold a certificate which shows him/her not in a good economic situation and is approved by a local government. His/her economic situation has to be authenticated by his/her university.
- The applicant must have an excellent academic record or an award in his/her professional area. His/her academic record must be 1/3 of total students in a class.
- The applicant must satisfy requirements of his/her university.

Award

- The hardship includes a return flight ticket, tuition fee, and living expense. A university has to subsidize a recipient 20% of the total amount offered by the Ministry of Education.
